**METRO DISTRICT APPOINTS DEPUTY MANAGER AND DISTRICT MANAGER DESIGNEE**

**DENVER**, March 26, 2008 — Metro Wastewater Reclamation District Manager Catherine R. Gerali has appointed Dan J. Schuler as deputy manager/director of administrative services and Steven M. Rogowski as district manager designee/director of operations and maintenance.

In the absence of the district manager, Schuler will serve as the district manager, with all of the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the district manager. If there is a vacancy in the position of district manager, Schuler will serve as the district manager until the Board of Directors selects a new district manager.

Rogowski will serve as acting district manager in the event both Schuler and Gerali are absent from the Metro District at the same time. He will have all the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the district manager when serving in that capacity.

Schuler began his career at the Metro District in February 1989 as the finance and accounting administrator. He has been director of administrative services since November 1989.

Rogowski joined the Metro District in 2001 as a comprehensive planner in the office of the manager. He became director of operations and maintenance in April 2002.

Schuler and Rogowski will retain all of their existing responsibilities and will assume additional responsibilities in their respective positions of deputy manager and district manager designee.

The Metro Wastewater Reclamation District is the largest wastewater treatment agency in the Rocky Mountain West. It treats about 140 million gallons of wastewater a day and serves 1.6 million people in a 600-square mile service area that includes Denver, Arvada, Aurora, Lakewood, part of Westminster, Wheat Ridge, and Thornton, together with about 40 sanitation and water and sanitation districts in the metropolitan Denver area.
