**EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION SYSTEM TESTING SET FOR APRIL 16**

DENVER, April 15 — The Metro Wastewater Reclamation District will conduct a test of its plant-wide alarm and communication systems on Wednesday, April 16, at about 7:15 p.m. at its treatment facility at 6450 York Street.

Immediately following a test of the PA system, the District will conduct an audible alarm test of both the Klaxon and siren alarm systems.

This is a scheduled test of the alarm system. Neighbors around the Metro District's plant may be able to hear it, but they should not be alarmed. Similar testing of the alarm systems is projected for the first Wednesday of each month at 7:15 p.m.

The Metro Wastewater Reclamation District is the wastewater treatment agency for most of metropolitan Denver. It treats about 140 million gallons of wastewater a day and serves 1.6 million people in a 600-square mile service area that includes Denver, Arvada, Aurora, Lakewood, part of Westminster, Wheat Ridge, and Thornton, together with about 40 sanitation and water and sanitation districts in the metropolitan Denver area.
